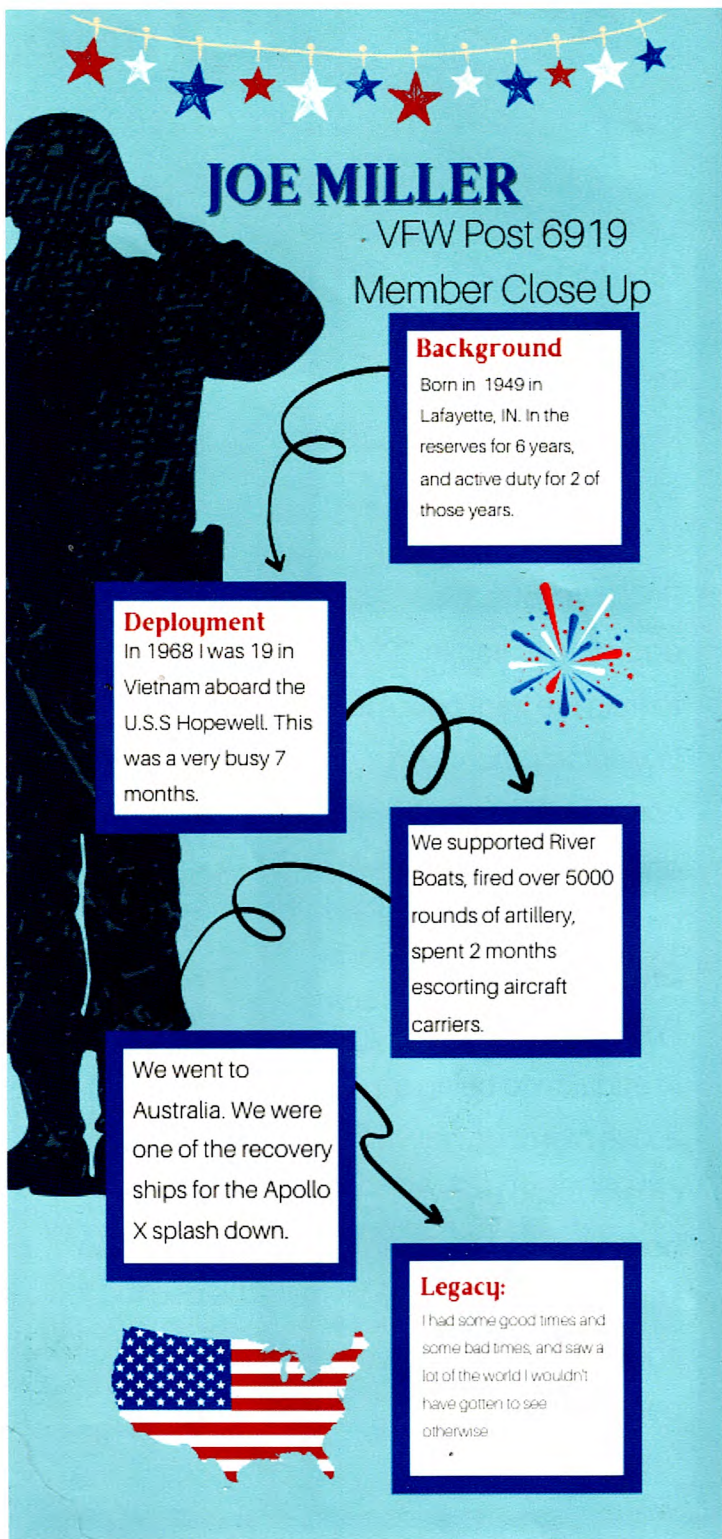

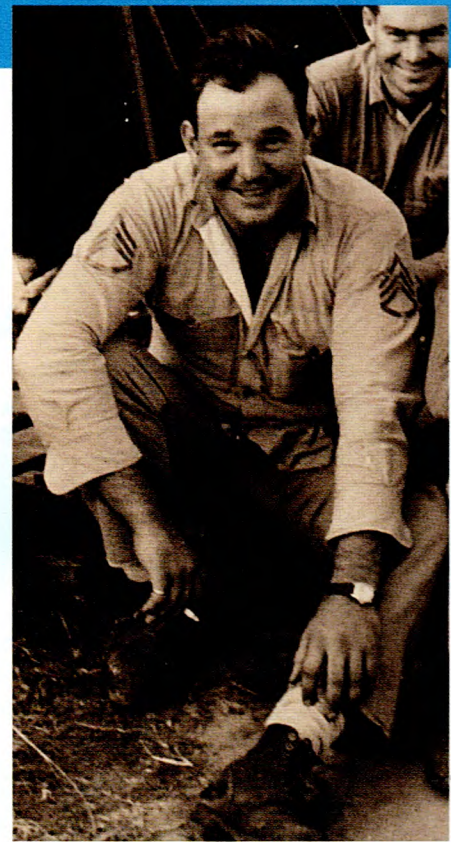
A FAMILY IN THE SERVICE

In his words

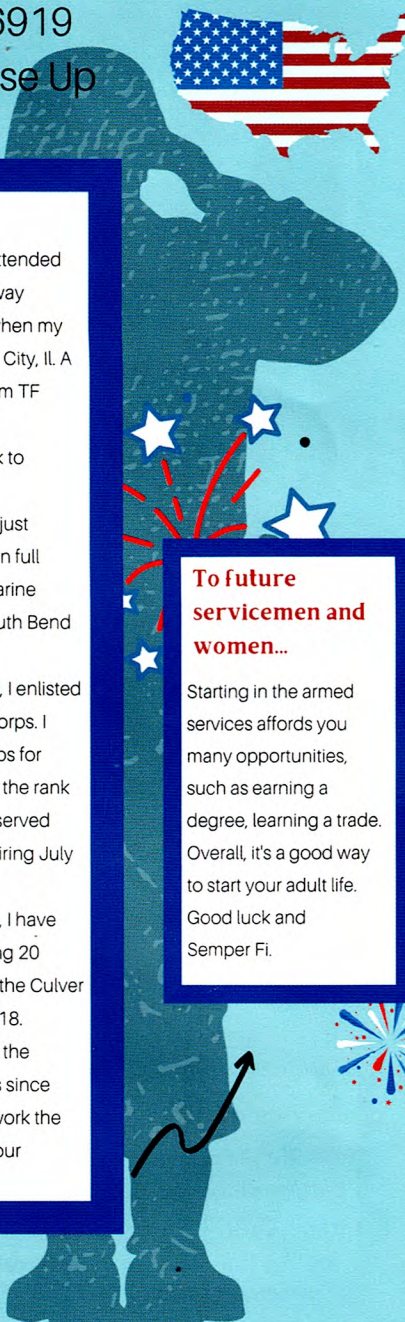
I grew up in Culver and attended Culver schools until midway through my junior year, when my family moved to Calumet City, IL. A year later, I graduated from TF North High School. After graduation, I moved back to Culver.

The war in Viet Nam was just beginning. The draft was in full swing. I enlisted in the Marine Corps Reserve unit in South Bend when I was 19.

While I was in boot camp, I enlisted into the regular Marine Corps. I served in the Marine Corps for nearly 22 years, attaining the rank of Master Sergeant, and served two tours in Viet Nam, retiring July 31st, 1987.

Since leaving the military, I have had several jobs, including 20 years as an electrician at the Culver Academies, retiring in 2018.

I have been a member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars since 1996. I am proud of the work the VFW and Auxiliary do in our community.

Luke Liette was a member of the 95th Infantry which was part of the 3rd Army under the command of George S. Patton. The men of the 95th were known as the "Iron Men of Metz". Metz is a city in France that was liberated from the Germans by the 95th Infantry in December 1944. To this day, the city of Metz annually recognizes the "Iron Men of Metz". During the war, Luke was wounded twice. He received three Bronze Stars and the Purple Heart. In 1958, Luke moved his family to Culver, IN and became a life member of Culver VFW Post 6919 in 1959. Unfortunately, Luke was hurt in an industrial accident in 1965 and died of his injuries in February 1966. His wife, Eleanor was left to raise five children, Paul, Kitty, Bill, Angela and Patty. Eleanor joined the Post 6919 Auxiliary in 1966 and remained a member until her death in 2014. She was chaplain for the auxiliary for over twenty years.



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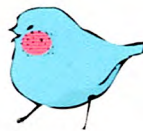

Eleanor also enrolled her daughters, Kitty Davis, Angela Loehmer and Patty Hankins as life members in 1970. Kitty and Patty are both active in the club as they help with the lunches and dinners. Bill joined the Army in November 1970 and served in the ASA (Army Security Agency) in Thailand during the Vietnam war. Bill was discharged from the Army in 1980 and joined the Culver VFW Post in 1974. Bill too is a life member.

Paul joined the Army in March 1970 and was discharged in March 1976. Paul was clerk-typist and worked in personnel and finance. He joined the Auxiliary in 2013 and he too is a life member. Paul is currently the treasurer of the Auxiliary of Post 6919 and assisting the Post with the Quartermaster duties.

As of today, all of Luke and Eleanor's children are life members of Culver VFW Post 6919, a 64 year tradition that continues.
